TRANSIT INFORMATION | vail.gov/bus

Vail Transit offers free and convenient bus service throughout Vail and is now offering its largest summer schedule ever. Core Transit also offers free bus service throughout the majority of Eagle County. More information is available at coretransit.org.

PARKING INFORMATION | vail.gov/parking

Vail Village Structure – [241 S. Frontage Rd E](#)

- 1 hour free, then \$2 per hour up to \$10
- Vehicles entering after 3 p.m. will receive free parking until 4 a.m.
- \$60 overnight fee

Lionshead Structure – [354 S. Frontage Rd W](#)

- 1 hour free, then \$2 per hour up to \$10
- Vehicles entering after 3 p.m. will receive free parking until 4 a.m.
- \$60 overnight fee

Red Sandstone Garage – [551 N. Frontage Rd W](#)

- 1 hour free, then \$2 per hour up to \$10
- \$35 overnight fee

Ford Park Lot – [720 S Frontage Rd E](#)

- 1 hour free, then \$2 per hour up to \$10
- No overnight parking
- \$20 event parking

Vail Athletic Fields/Soccer Lot – [646 Vail Valley Dr](#)

- 1 hour free, then \$2 per hour up to \$10
- No overnight parking
- \$20 event parking

OVERSIZED VEHICLES (RVs, Trailers, etc.)

Free parking is available on the south side of the North Frontage Rd across from the West Vail Mall where signs indicate, as well as both sides of the North Frontage Road west of Vail Fire Station 3 as signs indicate.

Overnight parking is available in the area marked with blue rope and flagging, west of Vail Fire Station 3. The fee is \$60 per 24 hours.
