

# TOWN OF VAIL, COLORADO MUNICIPAL COURT

## Fines and Points Schedule

---

This court-ordered fine schedule, per Colorado Municipal Court Rule 210(b)(5), outlines payable fines and offenses requiring a court appearance. It covers the Model Traffic Code (2020 edition, as amended), general ordinances, and parking violations.

**While this serves as a guideline, the judge has final authority on all fines and penalties, including those not listed.**

### Penalty Assessments or Mandatory Court Appearances

- If your citation is marked "Court," you must appear in court.
- If your citation displays a fine, you may pay it without attending court.
- If aggravating circumstances exist, an officer may require a mandatory appearance for any charge, even those that would typically be eligible for a payment.

### Payment Options

- To pay in person, visit the Vail Municipal Building, 75 S Frontage Rd W, Vail, CO 91657 between 8:30 and 4:30 PM Monday through Friday.
- To pay over the phone, with a credit card, call the court at 970-479-2129 between 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM Monday through Friday.

### Court Fees:

Court Cost \$25.00 / Jury Trial Cost \$50.00

### When criminal enforcement applies instead of civil enforcement

If the Town decides to pursue criminal enforcement instead of civil enforcement, or if a protest is filed (leading to the cancelation of a civil citation), a Summons and Complaint may be issued under the Colorado Municipal Court Rules of Civil Procedure.

### Violation Classifications

Violations are categorized based on their severity and legal classification:

- Class A Traffic Infractions (**TIA**) – Minor, non-criminal offenses.
- Class B Traffic Infractions (**TIB**) – More serious, non-criminal offenses.
- Petty Offenses (**PO**) – Criminal offenses with lesser penalties.
- Class 2 Misdemeanors (**M2**) – Serious misdemeanor offenses.
- Class 1 Misdemeanors (**M1**) – The most severe misdemeanor offenses.

## Driver's License Points

- Points are assigned based on the severity of the violation and its impact on road safety.
- A low fine does not necessarily mean fewer points, and a high fine does not always mean more points.

*The defendant shall pay a minimum mandatory fine of not less than five hundred dollars. The court may suspend up to one half of the fine upon a showing that appropriate insurance has been obtained. Nothing in this paragraph (a) shall be construed to prevent the court from imposing a fine greater than the minimum mandatory fine.*

*For a 2nd or subsequent conviction within five years, a mandatory minimum fine of \$1,000 applies. Up to half the fine may be suspended with proof of appropriate insurance. Additionally, the court may impose at least 40 hours of community service under section 18-1.3-507, C.R.S.*
