Objectives

This scholarship program is intended to provide recognition and financial support to qualified local residents and students interested in pursuing education and careers in the field of environmental sustainability.

This scholarship award honors the contributions of Mauri Nottingham to the Vail community. Mauri founded We Recycle, the valley's first recycling program in the early 90s and has demonstrated a commitment to recycling and re-use.

Scholarship recipients will embody the spirit of Mauri's environmental ethic and have demonstrated their commitment to environmental sustainability and Town of Vail values in our community.

Eligibility

Applicants may be high school students, local residents, or those employed within the Town of Vail who will be enrolled in sustainability or other related environmental education courses full-time or part-time in 2026. Preference will be given to those completing coursework at Colorado Mountain College. Those taking courses through other educational institutions may also apply.
