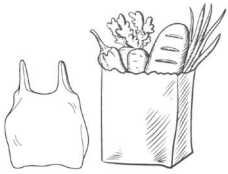


## Why am I being charged a bag fee?



The State of Colorado passed the Plastic Pollution Reduction Act (House Bill 21-1162) in 2021 to reduce and mitigate plastic pollution in Colorado.

Starting January 1, 2023, single use carryout bags distributed at Colorado retailers will incur a fee per carryout bag. Starting January 1, 2024, Colorado retailers will no longer be allowed to distribute single use plastic carryout bags.

The fee in the Town of Vail is \$0.25/single use carryout bag. Businesses retain 60% of the fee to cover the cost of administration and compliance. Town of Vail receives 40% of the fee to support recycling, waste diversion programs and related outreach and educational activities

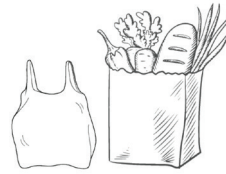

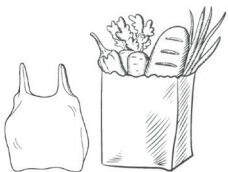

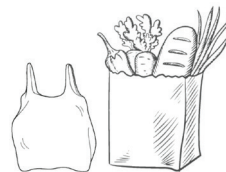
